

ATTENTION ALL KEMMERER & DIAMONDVILLE RESIDENTS

By now, you should have received the EPA Non-Compliance Notification included with your monthly water bill. This notice is required by federal law, and the wording contained within the notification is mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The Joint Powers Board is not permitted to modify or alter the required language.

This supplemental notice is being provided to help clarify the situation and provide additional context to our residents.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All routine water quality testing conducted throughout the residential areas of Kemmerer and Diamondville remains well within EPA drinking water standards.
- The non-compliance issue referenced in the EPA notice pertains to one isolated sampling location near the Sparkle Laundromat.
- The test result at that location exceeded the EPA limit by only 0.005 mg/L (five one-thousandths of a milligram per liter).

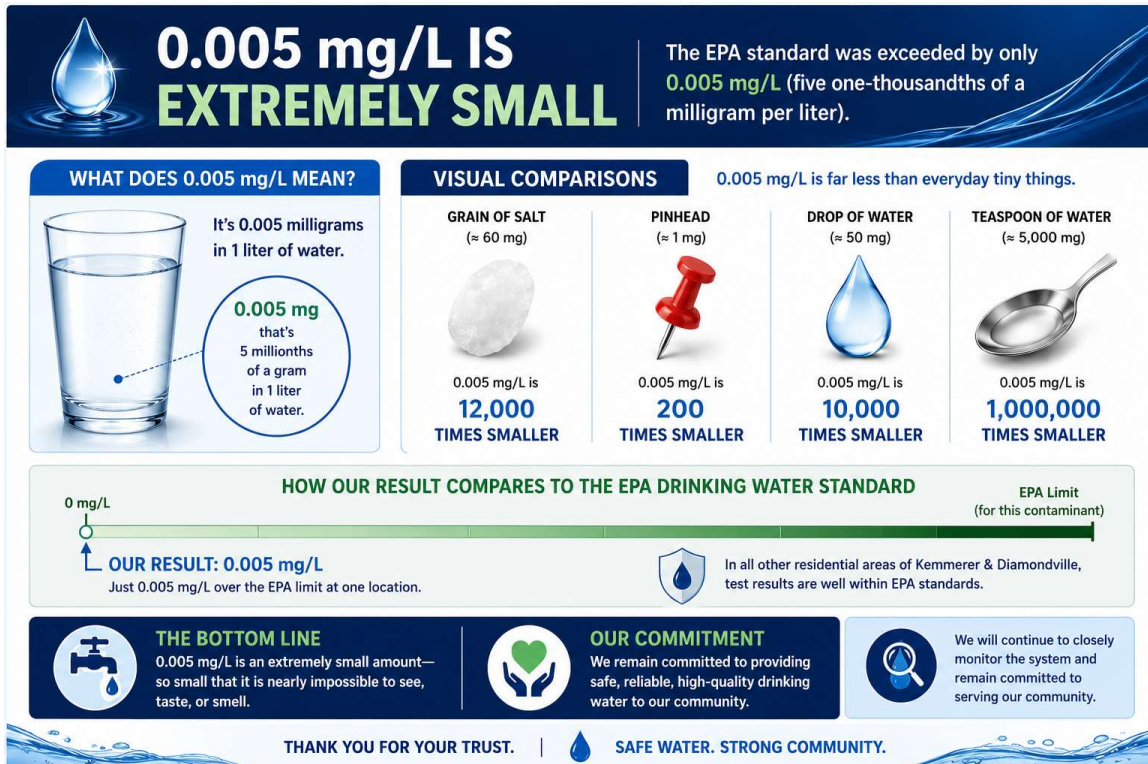


Illustration showing how extremely small 0.005 mg/L is in relation to common measurements.
